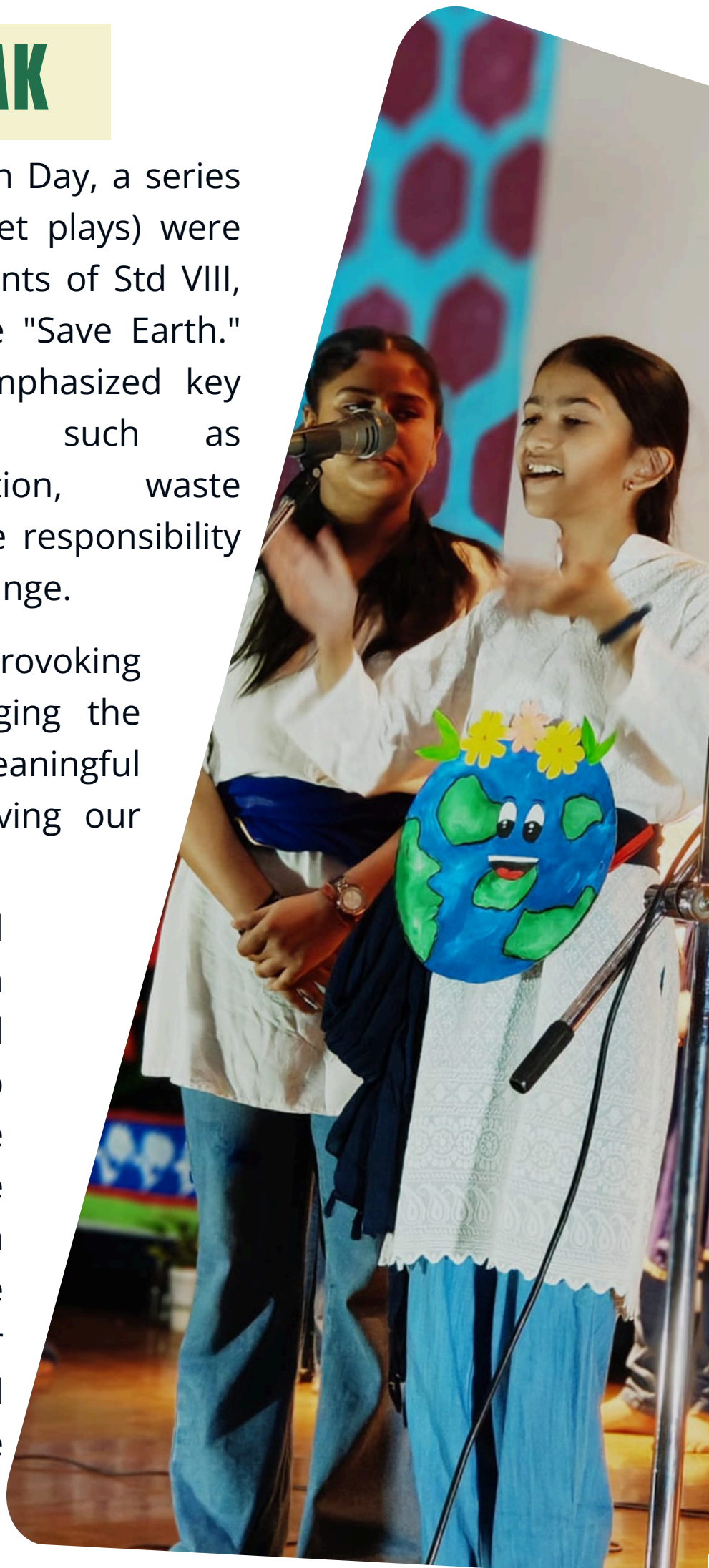


# NUKKAD NATAK

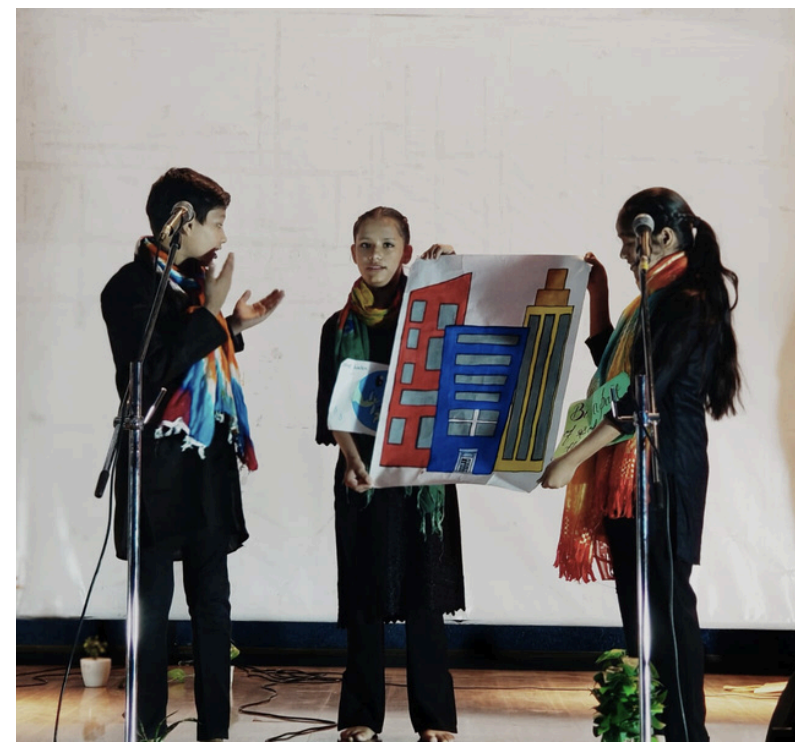
The event was thought-provoking and inspiring, encouraging the audience to take meaningful actions towards preserving our planet.
